Theatre by the Lake is Cumbria's professional producing theatre, bringing the world to Cumbria and Cumbria to the world.

Led by Artistic Director Liz Stevenson and Executive Director Simon Stephens, each year we present nearly 700 performances in our two auditoria and tour our home-made productions nationally and to communities across Cumbria. We also host touring theatre companies, as well as music, literature and festivals of film and the outdoors.

We create opportunities for people of all ages and interests, from developing local artists to engaging young people in all aspects of what we do. We also host performances by local charities and amateur companies.

From our origins as the Blue Box, Theatre by the Lake was willed into existence by the local community and opened in 1999. The theatre has been hailed by The Independent as 'the most beautifully located and friendly theatre in Britain' and is just a short stroll from Derwentwater on the edge of Keswick, amid the magnificent western fells of the Lake District, which has been awarded UNESCO World Heritage status.
